

Loggerheads, Sunday 15th February 2026,

B Walk

8 miles, 1800 ft ascent

Leader: Mike Donovan

This is a fairly strenuous B walk due to the climb up to Moel Famau. The route may be modified depending on weather conditions. Walking poles are recommended.

We start at Loggerheads (toilets) and follow the Leete path north along the river for 2 miles until we reach a country road to Cilcain. Turning left (west) we cross the river and then climb steeply up the other side. We follow the road (or a path across fields) to the village (toilets and shop).

From Cilcain, we turn south down another road to pick up the Clwydian Way, which takes us gradually (and steeply in parts) up to the summit of Moel Famau (lunch stop).

From here it is all downhill. First through woods and heath, then across fields and along tracks till we reach a lane that takes us back to Loggerheads car park.

Refreshments can be taken at We Three Loggerheads pub. The sit-down café at Loggerheads is closed due to building work, though takeaway drinks and snacks are still available.

C Walk

Distance 6.5 miles

From the drop off at Loggerheads we cross over the river, which was in full flow, onto a very good trail. This trail passes over a gorge which is accessible from a path closer to the river – closed due to flooding. We pass the turn off to Pontnewydd on the right (village not visible from the path) until we reach the road.

Turning left we follow this road, cross the river on the road bridge and continue slightly uphill for a short distance. We then turn off to the left onto a path crossing fields which were quite slippery until we reach the road from the village of Cilcain. A short stretch along this road we turn onto a path again, crossing fields to Crug Farm and continue towards Ffrith farm. There are some kissing gates, gates and styles from here on. This section was very boggy and muddy so be prepared!! Poles will be a big help as we come out of the field up onto the track to Ffrith.

This is a gradual climb. We then go downhill again, cross a stream on a good footbridge and pick up the road back to the carpark.

The toilets open at 10h00 so hopefully we will arrive around that time.

There is a small temporary cafe at the Centre and the pub is across the road.
